



CEMENT MIXTURE

Cement mixture is an artificial rock material resulting from the hardening of the slurry combining a binder, water, fine filler and mortar-improving additives. Coarser fillers are not used, since the mixture is applied in thin layers (wall lines etc.)

Concrete freeze-thaw durability is subdivided into grades F50, F75, F100, F150, F200 and so on.

Concrete water-resistance is graded W2, W4, W6, W8 etc.

Heavy concrete withstands greater surface wear, which is an important factor for concrete roads and industrial flooring.
